When you have completed your booking form pages, make note of the days you have chosen as a record for you to keep until we send the invoice out. Once you have received your invoice please check it carefully to ensure it agrees with your choices for your children.

**Placement Details Form** Please note that all of the children must have placement details forms completed and signed by both parents/guardians as a requirement of Ofsted regulations **before** they are left at the club for the first time. Please set up safety passwords for collection of your child/ren with staff.

**Healthcare Plans and Medication.** Please ensure that if your child has any allergies or medical requirements that you have completed a Healthcare plan for your child and supplied all necessary medication. **Without a completed Healthcare Plan your child CANNOT be left in the club.**

If we have a problem with your booking we will telephone you to discuss any issues. Any cancellations **MUST** be paid for after booking.

Any forms not received by the deadline date will have to take spaces available. As demand is high we prioritise for full time children.

Late bookings can be made if spaces are available by contacting the club after the return date, but a booking form will need to be completed before the place can be confirmed.

**Please remember that whatever time of year it is your children must bring appropriate clothing – sun cream and a hat in summer and if the weather is wet please supply an outdoor coat and wellies.**

Sensible footwear must be worn – NO crocs/flip flops/heels or backless shoes.

Hot meals are provided at Lunch time but if your child does not like what is on the menu, you are welcome to send a healthy packed lunch (NO NUTS). Please ask to see the menu or check our FB page.

Please note that all activities are provided but children also make spontaneous choices of activities that may deviate from those initially planned – it is their holiday club!

We now offer Forest School sessions as part of the club, there is no charge for these additional sessions but please ensure your child has a waterproof coat and Wellington boots with them.














**Water Activities in summer: If your child is in on these days they will need a swimming costume with an old t-shirt over the top, towel and wet shoes (or a pair of ordinary shoes that you don't mind getting very wet!)**

## Trips

- ♦ All Full Day Trips leave the Club between 8.30 and 09:30 and arrive back between 16:00 and 17:30. Please check the booklet for times. **We ask that you arrive 20 minutes before the stated departure time so that we can leave on time.** Please do not be late, if the vehicles have left we cannot look after your child on that day but you will still be charged for the day and the trip as tickets are booked in advance.
- ♦ Half Day Trips leave the club at 9.00am or 1.00pm and do not need a packed lunch but a drinks bottle and a snack in a bag is required.
- ♦ Packed Lunches. **Don't Forget!** Ice packs in a lunchbox will help keep foodstuffs cold and safe for your child as packed lunches are not refrigerated. Please be reminded that we are a **NUT FREE** setting so please ensure packed lunches do not contain any nuts. **The only nuts allowed on the trip are staff and children!**
- ♦ **Drinks Bottle and Rucksacks.** Please supply a drinks bottle for your child on trips and put lunches and drinks in a backpack as children will be carrying these with them. Any spare clothing should be in a separate bag that can be left in the bus. **Please remember your child will be carrying what you send.**
- ♦ Should a child forget to bring a packed lunch for a trip then we will provide your child with a sandwich, a bag of crisps, a piece of fruit, a cake and a drink and you will be charged an additional £5.00 for the provision of the meal. We will always try to provide your child with their choice of packed lunch but, as you will appreciate, we do not stock as large a range of foods as you might!
- ♦ **Spending Money.** Children are encouraged to bring a little money with them on trips as this is part of the enjoyment for them, but it is not a necessity if you would prefer them not to have it. We would ask parents that the **maximum** amount is £5 per child as the staff are unable to look after money for the children and we cannot choose what they spend it on but we will not allow them to spend it on sweets as part of healthy eating guidelines. Please provide a wallet/purse to keep it in.
- ♦ **Medication and Sunscreen.** Please ensure that all medication required for the trip is supplied on the day and labelled for your child. In the summer please ensure your child has sunscreen applied **prior** to departure on trips and has a supply to be applied during the trip.
- ♦ **Suitable clothing and footwear.** Please ensure your child has suitable clothing and footwear and any additional items as stated on the booking form.

If my/our child/ren do not comply with valid instructions given by those running the Forest School Session then my/our child/ren will be excluded from the session for the safety of all the other participants

I/We agree to make payment of fees promptly when they are due. Failure to pay fees in advance will result in a late payment charge of £8.00 per day plus a removal of all discounts applied for the club.

If I/we have indicated that my/our child has an allergy, food intolerance or food preference I/we have read the Healthcare, wellness and preference plans Policy and have completed the relevant "Traffic Light" form.

We constantly strive to make Smiz Kids 511 better for the children who use it. To that end we need input from as many people as possible to make these changes. Smizkids runs in a purpose built building at the back of the Nursery. The club has an interactive whiteboard and a Nintendo Wii with loads of team games.

Children cannot bring mobile phones into the club under any circumstances. We will return any to parents at the end of the day. Other electronic items should not be brought into the club

Any film, Wii game or other games cartridge brought into the club must be an original licensed version. Copies must not be brought into the club under any circumstances and must be an appropriate certificate. Games for the Wii or other consoles are age 3+ only classification. Any films shown in the club are Certificate U only. (Unless we have permission for PG rated films.)

A hot lunch is provided at lunchtime and a **light tea** in the afternoon (Sandwiches, crisps, salad, cakes, fruit etc.). The **light tea** in the afternoon is not meant to be a meal replacement for their evening meal. Children must bring a packed lunch for any full day trips. All other drinks and snacks are provided. All full day trips leave and return at set times so please check the booklet. If the vehicles have left we cannot look after your child on that day but you will still be charged.

Please note each day there are planned activities, which may include Forest School sessions planned or led by Julie, but children may choose to engage in any other activity on offer. Also trips are weather dependant. If we have to cancel you will not be charged for the trip.
